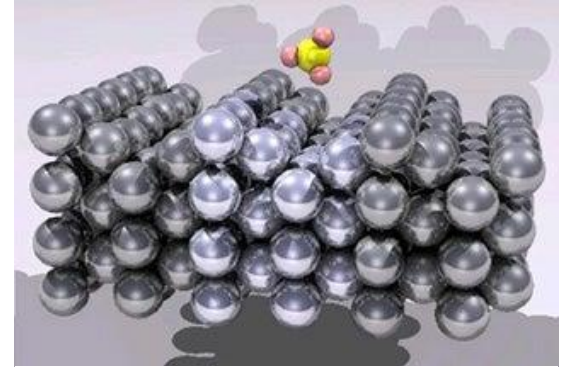

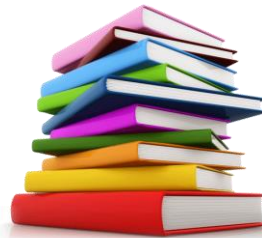
P.E lessons run by Nick are on Friday. Please make sure children come appropriately dressed for outdoor P.E. during these cooler months

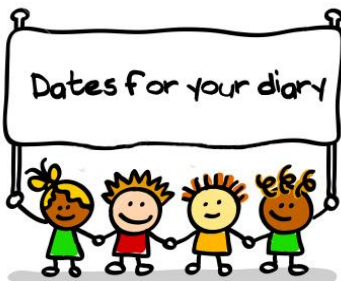
