## Mathematics (M)

### I will be learning to:

- Solve real world mathematical problems with numbers up to 5.
- Compare quantities using language: 'more than', 'fewer than'
- Know that the last number reached when counting a small set of objects tells you how many there are in total ('cardinal principle').

## Understanding the World (UW)

I will be learning to:

Understand the key features of the life cycle of a plant and an animal.

Begin to understand the need to respect and care for the natural environment and all living things.

## Physical Development (PD)

I will be learning to:

Explore a range of climbing, balancing and sliding apparatus, wheeled toys, balls and hoops in the outside area.

To develop my pencil control and will be encouraged to talk about the marks we make

To improve my fine motor skills through threading beads, and cutting with scissors.

To become independent in using the toilet and in putting on my own coat and doing up the zip!

## Communication and Language (CL)

**I will be learning to:**

**Enjoy listening to longer stories and can remember much of what happens**

**Use longer sentences of four to six words.**

## Personal Social Emotional Development (PSED)

I will be learning:

To develop appropriate ways of being assertive

To talk with others to solve conflicts

Talk about their feelings using words like 'happy' 'sad' 'angry' 'or' 'worried'.

## Literacy (L)

I will be learning to:

Develop phonological awareness, so that i can:

- spot and suggest rhymes
- count or clap syllables in a word
- recognise words with the same initial sound, such as money and mother
