Know how to answer 'Why' questions about jobs

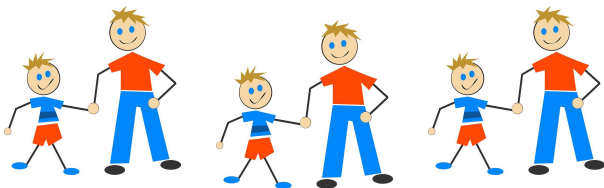
## Literacy (L)
