Communication and language

Remember much of what happens in familiar stories.

Sing a large repertoire of songs

Know some vocabulary related to the time since dinosaurs existed.



Maths

Know how to compare the length of dinosaurs by measuring

Know how to compare the weight of 2 things

Know how to use shapes appropriately: flat surfaces for building, a triangular prism for a roof, etc. Combine shapes to make new ones – an arch, a bigger triangle, etc

Physical Development

Learning to mount stairs, steps and climbing equipment using alternate feet.
Learning to stand momentarily on one foot.
Know how to use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils.
Know how to write some or all of our name

Understanding the World

Know that there are different ways to melt frozen items e.g. 'frozen dinosaur eggs!'

Know dinosaurs existed a long time ago- understanding a basic timeline.

Know the differences between materials and talk about changes they might notice.

Literacy

Know how to use some of their print and letter knowledge in their early writing.
For example: writing a pretend shopping list that starts at the top of the page;
writing 'm' for mummy

Expressive arts and design

Know , remember and sing entire songs.

Know how to play instruments with increasing control to express their feelings and ideas or representing different dinosaur steps.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Know how to use my words to solve conflicts
Play with one or more other children, extending and elaborating play ideas.

Know I am safe in my setting and show more confidence in new social situations
