



## June 2022

**We are going to learn about water!**

### Maths

Know vocabulary associated with position through words alone – for example, “The bag is under the table,” – with no pointing.

Know that the last number reached when counting a small set of objects tells you how many there are in total (‘cardinal principle’).

### Physical Development

Making sure we are completely independent with dressing skills – especially doing up buttons and zips!

Use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils.

Know how to write some or all of our name

Know to consider and manage the risk of being out in the sun – we will learn about wearing hats and glasses and using sun cream.

### Literacy

Know how to use some of their print and letter knowledge in their early writing. For example: writing a pretend shopping list that starts at the top of the page; writing ‘m’ for mummy

To know how to write all or some of their names

### Expressive arts and design

Know how to draw with increasing complexity and detail, such as representing a face with a circle and including details. Know how to use drawing to represent ideas like movement or loud noises.

### Communication and language

Listen to stories remembering much of what happens

Question why things happen

Know some new vocabulary about water

### Understanding the World

Know about the senses we use to explore natural materials

Know we need to respect and care for the natural environment and all living things.

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Know how to look after our environment / mini beasts and planting seeds in the garden

Be aware of and sensitive to each other’s feelings.

Know I can say if I need help in new situations. Be confident to talk to other children when playing.
