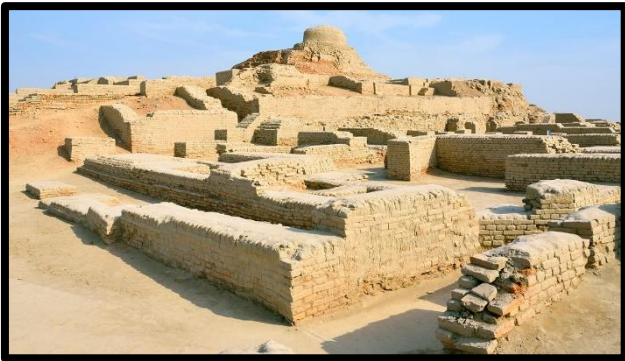


# New World to New Delhi

Year 6 Autumn 2



Science - This half term we will be learning more about living things and their habitats. We will consider how animals are classified, as well as investigating microorganisms.

Maths - We will continue to embed our understanding about the four operations, while also further developing our knowledge about fractions, decimals and percentages.

PSHE - Democracy is a big feature of our lessons this half term, through discussions in topic lessons to specific PSHE lessons about voting and elections.

## Key dates

Monday 1<sup>st</sup> November - School opens

Topic - We will be carrying on with our new topic this half term. However, we will now change our focus to India, looking at its geography and history. We will learn about coordinates and the Indus Valley Civilisation, as well as the start of the East India company and the impact of British rule.

English and Reading - We will be continuing our reading of Wonder by R.J. Palacio in class. We will also continue to explore other fiction and non-fiction books. At home, children should be reading 3-4 times a week and this should be recorded in their diaries.

Homework - Children will be given weekly Maths and English homework each Thursday and it will be due each Tuesday.

It is also expected that children read, practise the spellings (that are in their diaries), and their times tables (using TT Rockstars), at least 3-4 times a week. Only the reading needs to be recorded.
