



This half term you will be learning about the struggle for power between the Anglo Saxons and the Vikings. We will look at who the Anglo Saxons and the Vikings were, how and why they came to England, how we know about them and the impact they had on the country.

Maths

Our maths learning this half term will focus on embedding some concepts we have looked at before, such as fractions, decimals and percentages, as well as looking at new concepts, including algebra, and perimeter, area and volume.

Science

In this half term we will be looking at developing our knowledge and skills when completing a scientific investigation. We will practise asking questions, how we can measure, record and present information, as well as how to make conclusions.
