In Art, we will find out about the artist Andy Warhol and use his paintings as inspiration for our own artwork based around British Landmarks.

We will be using our geographical skills to locate and name British cities using eight compass points as well as the major UK rivers and surrounding seas. We will also explore high and low ground, UK mountain ranges and borders and boundaries.
