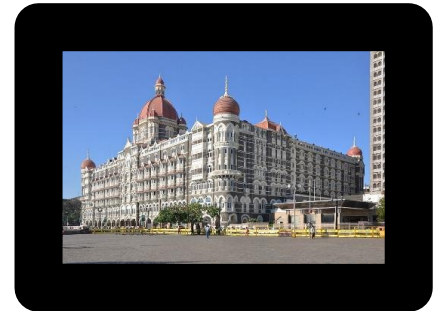


Room Service! Year 6 Unit 4

This half term we will be exploring the leisure and tourism industry through our topic, Room Service!

Using TinkerCad, you will become architects and design your own 5 star hotel. In addition to developing our computing skills, the unit will help us understand more about physical and human geography, as well as investigating the potential impact building a hotel could have on the environment in our geography lessons.



Homework

It is important that children complete their weekly maths and English homework set on Google classrooms, as well as weekly spellings, times tables and reading.

Key Maths Learning

- Area and Perimeter
- Measure
- Ratio

Geography

- Use fieldwork to measure and record data about our environment.
- Know about physical geography such as energy production and land use.

Reading

We will continue to read a variety of fiction (Skysteppers by Katherine Rundell), nonfiction (Guardians of the Planet) and poetry (The Listeners by Walter de la Mare).

Writing

We are continuing to develop our skills when writing for different purposes, such as to entertain, persuade and inform. We will also be further developing our use of punctuation and sentence structure.

Science

This unit will be about electricity.

- Know about voltage and amps
- Know about series and parallel circuits and their differences.
